

Scope

This course provides training for officers and ratings assigned specific duties and responsibilities related to cargo and cargo equipment on tankers and who have not previously served on board an oil tanker as part of the regulation complement. It comprises a familiarization training programme appropriate to their duties and responsibilities, including characteristics of tanker cargoes, their associated hazards, safety measures, pollution prevention, emergency operations, cargo equipment and operations.

Any of this training may be given on board or ashore. It should be supplemented by practical instruction on board and, where appropriate, in a suitable shore-based installation.

Objective

The syllabus of this course covers the requirements of the IMO Model course 1.01 and the 1995 STCW Convention Chapter V/1, Section A- VI/1, Table A-V/1. Provided they hold an appropriate certificate and are otherwise qualified in accordance with regulation V/1-1.2 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers 1978, as amended in 1995, those successfully completing the course should be able to assume the duties and responsibilities related to cargo and cargo equipment, as specifically assigned to them.
