

Aims

This course provides training for masters, chief engineers, officers and any person with immediate responsibility for the loading, discharging and care in transit or handling of cargo. It comprises a specialized training programme appropriate to their duties, including chemical tanker safety, pollution prevention, operational practice and obligations under applicable laws and regulations.

Any of this training may be given on board or ashore. It should be supplemented by practical instruction on board and, where appropriate, in a suitable shore-based installation.

Objective

The syllabus of this course covers the requirements of the IMO Model course 1.04 and the 1995 STCW Convention Chapter V/1-2.2, Section A- VI/1, Table A-V/1

Provided they hold an appropriate certificate and are otherwise qualified in accordance with regulation V/1-2.2 of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers 1978, as amended 1995, those successfully completing the course should be able to take immediate responsibility for loading, discharging and care in transit or handling of cargo on chemical tankers.
